ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Eligible applicants:

Some destinations are open both to Bachelor's and Master's students, some others only to one of the two. Please carefully check the admission requirements in Attachment 1 and details about the level for each destination.

In order to apply, students need to prove the language knowledge of at least the same level required by the destination (check attachment 1 "requisiti linguistici al momento della candidatura"), according to one of the following modalities:

- by uploading an internationally recognized certificate - please refer to <http://www.cla.unitn.it/575/certificazioni-hai-un-certificato> (certificate to be uploaded in the online application form)
- by being a mother-tongue speaker (to be declared in the application form).
- by having passed the language exam within the study program at the University of Trento, provided it is of the same or higher level required (to be declared in the application form);

- by having passed the oral and written test for the extra-curricular English or German language courses of the Dept. of Economics and Management (certification to be uploaded in the online application form);
- by having a high School diploma or University degree achieved in a country where the official language is the same as the one of the destination (copy of the certificate to be uploaded in the online application form);
- by having passed a language test at CLA in the frame of other mobility selection calls (to be declared in the application form).
- limited to the English language, by being enrolled in a master's course held in English with a language admission requirement of the same or higher level required (to be declared in the application form);

Should the linguistic requirement not be fulfilled in any of the above ways, students can take a written and oral exam organized by the CLA before the call deadline. Candidates have to **apply for the language test by October 25th, 2016 at noon** through the application available at the page: <http://web.unitn.it/node/10198/>

The calendar of the tests will be published at the page: <http://web.unitn.it/node/10198/>. Applicants will NOT receive any notification by email.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Applications are to be made through the Esse3 system (logging in by inserting personal user name and password) and must be saved and closed **no later than 6^h December 2016, at noon**. We recommend to finalize the application some days before the deadline.
- Candidates can apply for maximum 2 destinations.

Please attach to each application the following documents:

1. A motivation letter in Italian (or English for foreign candidates) and in the language required by the host University including your learning objectives;
2. The CV in Europass format (in Italian/or English and in the language required by the host University) [http://europass.cedefop.europa.eu/it/documents/curriculum-vitae/templates-instructions](http://europass.cedefop.europa.eu/it/documents/curriculum-vitae/templates-instructions;);
3. International certification of the language required (if applicable), according to the specifications above.

SELECTIONS

Eligible candidates who have closed the application by the deadline will be admitted to the interview with a Selection Committee who will evaluate each candidate according to the following criteria:

- a) Motivation letter (maximum 35 points);
- b) Interview and curriculum (maximum 35 points).
- c) UniTrento GPA (*) or the grade of the latest degree achieved (maximum 30 points);

(*) The GPA will be taken into consideration only starting from the minimum threshold of 20 ECTS registered by 31st October 2016. If this is not the case, the grade of the latest degree achieved will be taken into consideration.



Each applicant will be given a mark. The threshold for eligibility is 70. The mobility will be possible only up to the maximum number indicated for each destination. The final admission of the selected candidates is however up to the partner Universities.

Applicants will NOT be notified by email. Please note that all the information about the selection process and any changes to the calendars will be available on the web page <http://web.unitn.it/node/10198/>, so please double-check the page!

STUDY GRANT

Acceptance or refusal of the scholarship has to be communicated to the University of Trento within 5 days from the official notification.

The grant payment will be done in two sessions:

- First half within two months after the departure;
- Second half within two months from the start of the second semester.

Students who do not pass at least half of the yearly total amount of ECTS may be requested to return the scholarship and be excluded from the double degree programme.

For further semester/s of mobility, if foreseen by the programme, the scholarship will be consequently extended.

The grant-holder interrupting the stay without serious reasons will be asked to return the money already received.

Students who do not graduate within 12 months after the validation of all ECTS required by the study course, will be excluded from the Double Degree program and will not be allowed to get the double degree. Single and motivated exceptions will be evaluated.

Students participating in the double degree programme must remain enrolled at the University of Trento for the whole duration of the programme.
