Please check below the details of the required Application package for a correct application:

<p>Transcript of records</p>	<p>Upload a scan of your updated Transcript of records to the online application. Documents must be in English or Italian. Please express your Grade Point Average (GPA) in percentage terms (e.g. 78%). In order to calculate the GPA (up to 100%) consider the weighted mean of your grades as reported on your Transcript of records and turn it into %.</p>
<p>GMAT or GRE</p>	<p>GMAT/GRE are not compulsory, but strongly encouraged in order to certify your attitude to management studies. GMAT scores lower than 500 (or equivalent GRE) will not be considered. Applicants with GMAT/GRE have good chances to be admitted. If you have GRE please refer to the GRE/GMAT Comparison Chart.</p> <p>The GMAT test can be taken at the University of Trento GMAT Test Centre.</p>
<p>English language certification</p>	<p>Minimum level: B2 (suggested C1). The English language is a mandatory requirement for being admitted to the selection and can be certified as follow :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • English native speaker • International Certificate: please refer to the art. 2 of the Call for the accepted Certificates and the expiration date (ex. IELTS min. 6, TOEFL, Cambridge FCE, CAE; CPE, etc..) • Previous Bachelor Degree entirely in English (upload an official statement from your University that certifies that courses and exams were held in English) • GMAT score 580 or higher • Have passed the B2 English language exam or higher in another University* <p>* the Admission Committee may require an interview with the applicant during the evaluation process to check the English language knowledge.</p>
<p>Statement of purpose</p>	<p>Statement of purpose (max. 3000 characters - spaces included and in English language) is one of the most important criteria. Please provide information on your motivation for the Master's program, your extracurricular activities and your work experience. Focus on you future rather than on your past experiences. Three major points should be extensively explained:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Why would you like to study in this Master? • How do you see your professional future in five years? • How will the Master assist you in obtaining these goals? <p>Tip: do not just list your past experiences as they are explicated in your CV: rather use your past successes (and failures!) to show that you would fit into the program.</p>
<p>Two letters of recommendation</p>	<p>At least two letters of recommendation should be written by your professors at the university and/or by managers in your company. A mixture of academic and business letters of recommendation may be the</p>



	<p>best solution if you have significant work experience after graduating or as intern during your studies.</p> <p>Reference letters must be sent via e-mail directly to the Master Manager (main@unitn.it) by the referee(s) selected by the applicant and indicated in the dedicated section of the online application form. It is the applicant's responsibility to contact the referees and ask them to send the reference letter via email to the Master Manager. The University of Trento may contact the referees after receiving the reference letters for further information. Reference letters should not be attached in the online application form: they must be sent within the application deadline from the referees' institutional e-mail address. Once the reference letter has been received, the University of Trento will send a confirmation email.</p> <p>!!Letters sent from personal e-mail addresses, e.g. name@yahoo.it, as well as reference letters sent in any other way that doesn't respect the mentioned procedure and requirements, will not be considered.</p>
CV	<p>A brief but complete CV (as pdf file) should highlight the most important steps of your academic and professional career and include information about permanent contact and present address, phone number and e-mail as well as a Skype contact if available.</p>
